B-282173 Because of the time needed to identify the cause of an outbreak, country-of-origin labeling would not generally be useful in preventing more consumers from becoming ill. For example, when cyclospora-contaminated raspberries from Guatemala caused outbreaks of illnesses in 1996 and 1997, many individuals did not become ill until a week or more after they ate the fruit. officials said that country-of-origin labeling might be a starting point in CDC tracing the source of contamination if a person who had eaten a contaminated product remembered the source for that product. However, they said that more detailed information identifying every step from farm to table - for both domestically grown and imported produce - would be of greater use in tracing the source of an outbreak and identifying the practices that resulted in the contamination.
