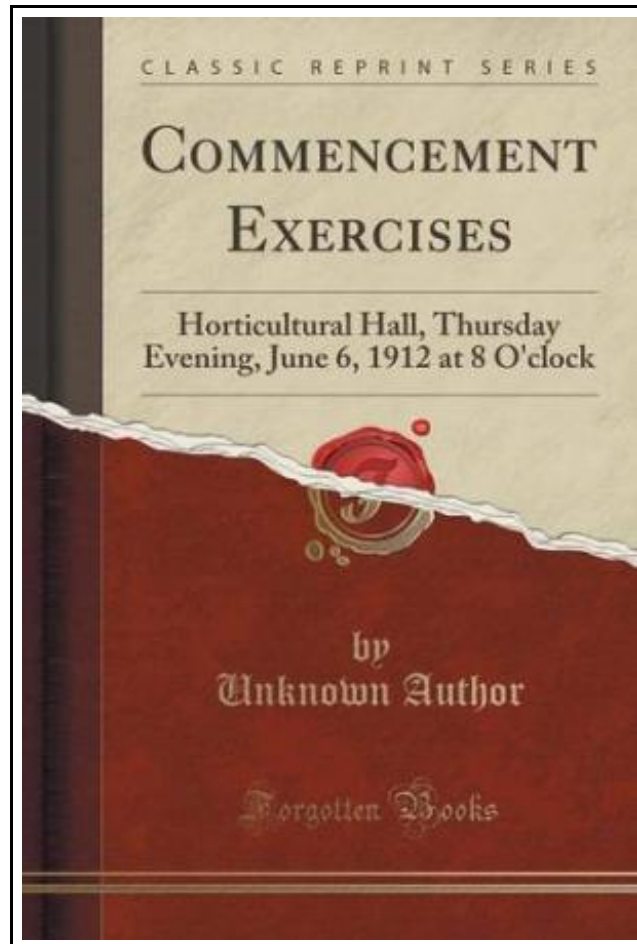

Numerically this registration is a little less than that of last year, but the falling off is more than accounted for by the discontinuance or discouragement of certain elementary work in special and part-time classes which the school had been willing to conduct temporarily for the benefit of teachers and pupils of the primary grades in the public schools, but which it was not deemed wise to carry on any longer. In the classes in which the more serious and legitimate work of the school is done, there has been a substantial increase in the enrollment. In the regular classes of the Art Department, for example, the increased attendance is 64, more than two-thirds of which is in the day classes.
