Andrew Thorburn tells the history of policing in Bow Street, and sets out how the building was to be adapted and extended. The full designers brief for the museum is included, and an account of the fund raising and town planning negotiations. The two final chapters set out what happened when the project was ended. It is a story of creativity frustrated. One ends up wondering about the failure of a major public body to deliver. This book is a major contribution to understanding public/private partnerships for development, and how developers work. It...
