Moreover, further investigation shows that y. is more in accordance with T. than with the other members of the F.T.B. group: see lines 1382, y. seeyte, T. seite; 1548, y.T. and, F. thise, B. as; 1568, on his children; 1613, huge; 1649, hym a name; 1962, to, to; 2001, haue for saue; 2328, loivde stevene. In view of the circumstances above stated, it would appear that y. occupies a position intermediate between G. and F.; that, for the greater part, it presents a type of text showing affinities to the type of text from which it may be supposed R. or A. was derived; but...
