Plans that are sponsored by state and local governments are not subject to Title I of ERISA. Labor defined a safe harbor for 403 (b) plans sponsored by tax-exempt organizations. Sponsors that follow the safe harbor guidelines are not considered subject to Title I of ERISA because the plan is considered not to have been established or maintained by an employer. Sponsors of these plans must restrict their involvement in the plan to certain actions, or they will become subject to Title I of ERISA. Plans that are designed for highly compensated executives are generally excluded from certain parts of Title I of ERISA. Certain religious organizations may establish different kinds of retirement 12 plans, but they are generally exempt from Title I of ERISA. Regardless of whether or not plans are subject to Title I of ERISA, all DC plans are subject to...
