On July 21, 2010, we issued our report on the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Call to Action Plan for Runway Safety (the Plan). Reducing the risk of runway incursions is a critical part of FAA's mission to oversee and enhance the margin of safety of the National Airspace System. In 2007, FAA, airline, and airport officials created the Plan after several close calls at some of the Nation's busiest airports. We conducted this audit at the request of Senator John Rockefeller and Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison of the Senate Commerce, Science, and Transportation Committee, who asked that we review the current state of aviation safety, including a focus on runway safety issues. Our audit objective was to evaluate the effectiveness of actions taken as a result of FAA's Call to Action Plan for improving runway safety. This item ships from La Vergne, TN. Paperback.
